SHOULD YOU CHEW A HOST? Should you chew the Host when you receive Communion? Last weekend we celebrated Corpus Christi. Recently someone asked me if it was OK to chew the Host they receive. The Church doesn't have a position on whether a Catholic chews the Eucharist or not. The idea you shouldn't chew the host appears to have been the practice of some Catholics before the Second Vatican Council, which is where people are getting the idea that you shouldn't chew. But not chewing has never been required or even officially encouraged by the magisterium of the Church. What is required by the Church is that **Catholics receive communion** *reverently.* This means bowing before receiving, saying "Amen" in respond to "the Body of Christ," and receiving either on the hand or tongue. This is because the Eucharist is *not* ordinary food and drink but is Jesus Christ himself. - Fr. Henry
