CURSILLO MOVEMENT INFORMATION FOR SPONSORS

Sponsors of candidates for a Cursillo are responding in a very concrete way, to Christ's invitation to spread the Good News in our environments. It is a special blessing when we are chosen to be instruments in providing another with the opportunity to learn that only through Christ can we be truly alive. We know that our weekend was a very moving experience, but we can also remember all the reasons for putting it off.

The candidate will often need a lot of encouragement and support to make what seems like a sacrifice. The information which is attached to the Candidate's Application form provides answers to some of the questions which might be raised. As to the reasons why a person should make a Cursillo, you should think of your Fourth Day and what effect your weekend has had on your relationship with God, on your outlook on life, and on your values.

Sponsoring carries with it the responsibility to transport the candidate to and from the location. The main reasons for this are to ensure a timely arrival 7:00 pm, to allow you to answer questions that the candidate may have about the weekend and for you to make arrangements to attend Ultreya together. If transportation is a problem for you, seek help from other Cursillistas. Remember to advise your candidate of the NO SMOKING policy now in force at St. Ambrose Parish Centre - all smoking must be done outside.

When you are discussing a Cursillo weekend with a candidate, the matter of cost should be dealt with. It is unkind to leave the candidate with the uncertainty of the amount that he/she may be asked to pay. No one need feel embarrassed to talk about the cost. The facts are: accommodation and meals, rental of tables, the cost of Bibles, writing materials and other supplies, cost the Movement *§75.00* per person; the major source of funds for the movement are the financial contributions of everyone who attends the weekend - team, clergy and candidates. These funds are crucial to the continuation of the Movement. Regardless, as you know, no one has ever been denied a weekend because they were unable to pay. Please note that on Sunday everyone is given an envelope in which they are asked to place a contribution to cover the cost of the weekend. Should you wish to make a contribution in an envelope when you bring him/her to the weekend and give it to the candidate.

In keeping with the objectives of Cursillo, candidates should be active in Church, community or charitable works, should be likely to follow through on a Fourth Day commitment and should demonstrate a love of god, family and concern for others.

Sponsors should be aware of their responsibilities to their candidates:

be willing to take their candidates to the Ultreyas
encourage and help their candidate to become a part of a weekly Group Reunion.
