ONGOING WORK AT ST. AMBROSE: The last few years, we have had to do some work to keep the church and Parish Center in good shape. Did you know that over the past few years we have received 3 grants of \$25,000 each. With this money we replaced the furnaces in the Parish Center and renovated the men's and women's restrooms in the lower level. During the winter, in St. Ambrose church, we fixed the window that was being pushed in and are currently working on the entrance to the

Jubilee Room/Church. Some projects planned for this year: replacing the wooden side steps to the church on the Green Street side which are getting in bad shape and the drainage in front of the Adoration Chapel. Also, we are looking at fixing the leak by sacristy and replacing the few remaining old windows in the basement. There are always things to do when you have an older building. Fr. Henry
